Agreement

School Aims

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How we can work in partnership for the benefit of our children.

As Parents / Guardians we will:

- Ensure that our child attends school regularly and arrives on time (by 8.50a.m.)
- If our child is invited, ensure that they arrive on time for before school tutoring (by 8:00a.m.)
- Ensure that our child is wearing the correct school uniform and is properly equipped e.g. has PE kit and any books or stationery as required.
- Inform the school by 9.20am, at the latest, if our child cannot attend school.
- Let the school know of any concerns or problems that might affect our child at school.
- Support the school's Christian ethos and policies.
- Encourage exemplary behaviour.
- Support our child in homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- Get to know about our child's life at school by attending parent consultation evenings, reading information sent out and ensuring good liaison between home and school.
- Get involved in the wider life of the school whenever possible.
- Ensure our child is safe on the internet and uses it responsibly.
- Respect all adults and children whilst visiting the school and when using social media sites like Facebook, Snapchat and Twitter.
- Follow procedures for airing concerns and complaints and not use social media to do so.
